

2005 IOWA LONG RANGE STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

NRA Registered Match (State Championship)

DATES: 17 - 18 September 2005.

LOCATION: Des Moines Rifle and Revolver Club range in Van Meter, IA, about 20 miles west of Des Moines. Take I-80 to Van Meter exit, # 113, turn south into town. Cross railroad tracks and take first left to range entrance. Local motel - Edgetowner Inn, Exit 110 (2.5 miles west of the Van Meter exit off I-80). Call (515) 834-2641 for reservations.

ELIGIBILITY: Competition open to current NRA members, U.S. Armed Forces members or National Guard/Reserve members. Junior competitors may be individual members of an NRA affiliated club in lieu of individual NRA membership. The Des Moines Rifle and Revolver Club reserves the right to accept or deny any entry. Iowa State Residents - membership required in the Iowa State Rifle & Pistol Association, applications will be available.

RULES: Current NRA High Power Rifle Rules (revised April 2003) will govern. 'F' Class competitors welcome.

REGISTRATION FEES:	Individuals (Saturday)	32.00 per comp.	(Pre-registration required).
	Junior (Saturday)	8.00 per comp.	(Pre-registration required).
	Palma Match (Sunday)	5.00 per comp.	(No pre-registration required).

INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES: **Payment required with advanced entries.** Entries with out payment will not be squadded until payment is made. The match is limited to 80 competitors. Make your entry on the attached entry card. **Please fill it out completely.** Make checks payable to the Des Moines Rifle and Revolver Club. Checks will be held until after the match.

Entries will close on 14 September 2005 at 9:00 PM CDT. Any no shows with out prior notification will forfeit any fee's paid. **All entries, including phone call entries received after the entry close date will be squadded as walk-on's.** Walk-on's will be permitted as long as space is available, no additional relays are needed, and re-squadding of pre-registered individuals is not necessary.

SQUADDING TICKETS: All matches will be squadded. Squadding tickets for individual matches on Saturday will be issued at the 600 yard line beginning at 8:00am. Squadding will close at 8:45 AM. Be prepared to present your NRA Long Range classification card. Squadding and fee collection for the Palma match will begin at 9:00 AM on Sunday morning.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA Classification system will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6 - Assigned Classification, or 19.2 - Temporary Classification, may be used in making entry in an NRA Registered Match.

OPEN BOLT INDICATORS: Open bolt indicators will be required and will be available at the range for \$ 1.50 each.

RIFLES ALLOWED: NRA Match Rifle - Rule 3.3, 3.3.1; or Service Rifle - Rules 3.1, 3.3.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.3. There will be two divisions for this match: NRA Match Rifle and the Service Rifle provided there are enough competitors in each division. If there are not enough competitors in each division, the divisions will be combined. Rifles with rainbow trajectories will not be allowed for safety purposes.

CHALLENGE FEE: \$ 3.00 for each challenge.

TARGET OPERATION AND SCORING: All competitors will be required to operate targets and score. A qualified substitute target operator will be allowed. Failure to complete target and scoring duties will result in disqualification and loss of match fees.

GENERAL INFORMATION: Lunch and drinking water will not be available. Outhouses are available. Camping is allowed on the range and at the smallbore and pistol ranges on top of the hill for free. The range gate will be unlocked by 6:00pm Friday evening, 16 Sept. for camping.

NEW MATCH RULE: Eye protection **required** during pit duties.

The highpower rifle range will be closed to live firing starting at 6:00pm Friday evening for range prep work.

600 YARD LONG RANGE INDIVIDUAL STATE CHAMPIONSHIP MATCH:

- MATCH 1: 2 SIGHTING SHOTS AND 20 ROUNDS FOR RECORD, PRONE, SLOW FIRE, 600 YARDS, MR-1 TARGET, 22 MIN. TIME LIMIT. ANY RIFLE, **ANY SIGHTS.**
- MATCH 2: REPEAT OF MATCH 1.
- MATCH 3: 2 SIGHTING SHOTS AND 20 ROUNDS FOR RECORD, PRONE, SLOW FIRE, 600 YARDS, MR-1 TARGET, 22 MIN TIME LIMIT, ANY RIFLE, **IRON SIGHTS.**
- MATCH 4: REPEAT OF MATCH 3.
- MATCH 5: AGGREGATE OF MATCHES 1-4.

AWARDS: Award groups must contain at least 5 competitors or they will be combined with the next higher class. If there are fewer than five high masters, they must compete for open awards only. There must be five or more entries for one award, eight or more for two awards, and 11 or more for three awards. Special individual awards will be given for High Woman and High Junior. If an individual wins a place award, they will not be eligible for a category/class award in the same match. Match Win, 2nd, 3rd (\$8,7,6) Class Win, 2nd, 3rd (\$5,4,3).

SUNDAY, 10:00 AM. CDT 18, SEPTEMBER 2005.

PALMA MATCH - REDUCED COURSE: (No pre-registration for this match. Squadding will be done at the 600 yard line beginning at 9:00am. Fees will be collected at that time).

Stage 1. 22 minutes, unlimited sighting shots, 15 shots for record at 300 yards. Long range reduced targets used.
Shooter must notify scorekeeper before 1st shot for record is taken.

Stage 2. 22 minutes, 2 sighting shots, 15 shots for record at 500 yards. 500 yard long range target.

Stage 3. 22 minutes, 2 sighting shots, 15 shots for record at 600 yards. MR-1 Target.

AWARDS - Match Win, 2nd, 3rd. Class Win, 2nd, 3rd and by Division. Dollar amount of awards to be determined by number of competitors firing.
Rifles Allowed - NRA Match, Palma, and Service Rifles - any (safe long range) caliber.
