ELIGIBILITY: Competition open to U.S. Citizens, U.S. Armed Forces members, and National Guard/Reserve members. The Des Moines Rifle and Revolver Club reserves the right to accept or deny any entry.

RULES: CMP Rules 7<sup>th</sup> Edition - John C. Garand Match Course A.

REGISTRATION FEES:	Individual Entry	30.00 per comp. ( Pre-registration required).
	Junior Entry	10.00 per comp. ( Pre-registration required).

INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES: **Payment required with advanced entries.** Entries with out payment will not be squadded until payment is made. The match is limited to 80 competitors. Make your entry on the attached entry card. **Please fill it out completely.** Make checks payable to the Des Moines Rifle and Revolver Club. **Checks will be held until after the match.**

**Entries will close on 12 October 2005 at 9:00 PM CST.** Any no shows with out prior notification will forfeit any fee's paid. **All entries, including phone call entries received after the entry close date will be squadded as walk-on's just prior to the start of the match.** Walk-on's will be permitted as long as space is available, no additional relays are needed, and re-squadding of pre-paid competitors is not necessary.

SQUADDING TICKETS: All matches will be squadded. Squadding tickets for individual matches will be issued at the 200 yard line beginning at 8:00am. Squadding will close at 8:45 AM.

OPEN BOLT INDICATORS: Open bolt indicators will be required and will be available at the range for \$ 1.50 each.

RIFLES ALLOWED: In the spirit of this competition, ALL rifles will be AS-ISSUE. M1 Garand - 30-06, M1 Carbine - .30 cal, Model 1903 Springfield - 30-06, US Johnson. For squadded practice - any other SAFE NRA Match or Service Rifle. Any competitors found to be shooting 'tuned up' rifles will automatically forfeit any awards. Competitors using tuned up rifles are welcome but will fire the match as a squadded practice match. Winner of the match will be subject to having their rifle inspected before the awarding of the Trophy.

AMMUNITION: Club will provide 30-06 and .30 Carbine ammo.

ALIBIS: There will be no weapons malfunction or ammo missfire re-fires, only range and pit alibis if necessary.

TARGET OPERATION AND SCORING: All competitors will be required to operate targets and score. A qualified substitute target operator will be allowed. Failure to complete target and scoring duties will result in disqualification and loss of match fees.

GENERAL INFORMATION: Lunch and drinking water will not be available. Outhouses are available. Camping is allowed on the high power range and at the smallbore and pistol ranges on top of the hill at no charge. The range gate will be unlocked by 6:00pm Friday evening, 14 October, for camping.

**The highpower rifle range will be closed to live firing starting at 6:00pm Friday evening to allow for match prep work.**

NEW MATCH RULE: Eye protection **required** during pit duties.
